- Continuously improve our environmental performance and environmental system to make pollution prevention a prerequisite for all operations.
- Reduce the use of environmentally harmful materials.

- Where appropriate, set realistic and measurable environmental objectives and targets which are regularly reviewed and improved upon
- Ensure that Torishima publishes its Environmental policy, performance and makes available relevant environmental information to its employees, customers and other interested parties, as required.
- Train and communicate to all employees in the importance of the organisation's environmental policy, objectives, IMS, and encourage active participation.
